Herbaceous Perennials

Welcome once again to my monthly gardening feature. July has certainly had some very hot days but at least the slugs and snails have been less of a problem! Watering has been a daily necessity though for most of this month, it is always best to water your



plants first thing in the morning to prevent scorching by a hot sun and to discourage any lurking snails and slugs as it will have dried off by the evening when they prefer to come out.

This month, as we still have plenty of growing time, I thought I would focus on Potentilla fruticosa. This shrub flowers prolifically from May to October and is largely resistant to both rabbits and deer. It comes in a variety of colours and tolerates our local conditions, and happily grows in containers. It can also be used to form an informal hedge but prefers a well drained soil in a sunny position. There are a number of varieties and depending on the variety grows up to 1m+ height by 1m+ spread. Potentilla fruticosa is also easy to maintain but benefits from pruning once a year in the late autumn/winter.



My favourite colour is the yellow one as pictured below which I have in my own garden. This flowers constantly from early May all the way through to October.

Finally if you are growing your own potatoes do keep a close eye on the shaws for evidence of potato blight, especially if the weather is warm and humid. The first indications of potato blight are purple/black spots on the leaves quickly turning yellow as they start to go back. You can either spray with an appropriate spray or cut the shaws down completely

to prevent the blight getting into the potatoes. Remove all shaws as far away from any healthy potato/tomato plants as possible as it spreads easily.
